Mr. Andreas Papaetis is a Senior Policy Expert in the Digital Finance Unit of the European Banking Authority, focusing on Operational Resilience related topics. Since joining the EBA in January 2017, he worked on banking supervision policy areas such as Supervisory Review and Evaluation Process and Pillar 2 and conducted supervisory convergence work. From 2018, Andreas has been actively involved in delivering the EBA's FinTech Roadmap, such as the analysis of FinTech impact on institutions' business models and the development of the EBA thematic report on Big Data and Advanced Analytics. In the last few years, Andreas is leading the policy development in the area of operational resilience, including the EBA Guidelines on ICT and security risk management as well as the ongoing policy development under the new Digital Operational Resilience Act (DORA). Andreas also represents the EBA in related topics at European and international level.

Andreas started his career at one of the Big Four accounting and consulting firms in Cyprus and before joining the EBA, he was working for a global systemically important bank in London. Andreas holds a BSc in Business Mathematics and Statistics and MSc in Finance from the London School of Economics and Political Sciences, and he is an ICAEW Chartered Accountant (ACA).
