Silke Lechtenberg is Chief Information Security Officer (CISO) for Deutsche Bank AG - Germany. She represents Information Security within the bank at appropriate committees in Germany, covers relevant external relationships (i.e., regulators, government agencies, banking associations and industry groups in Germany) and leads regional initiatives.

In addition, Silke has global responsibility for the "Chief Security Office (CSO) Third Party, Regulatory, Audit and External Engagement" function.

Within her global function, she strengthens collaborative relationships with external stakeholders (including government agencies etc.) and ensures consistent external representation and adherence to regulatory frameworks. It also requests and drives the delivery of security events for clients and security awareness campaigns for employees. Furthermore, she is accountable for IS Third Party (Supply chain) risk and drives internal and external audit engagement and risk mitigation.

Silke joined Deutsche Bank in 2013 as Head of Shared Application Services for the former Private and Business Clients (PBC) division, focusing on quality assurance for the SAP platform migration programme, and cross-functional services including the set-up of a security risk and control function. In this context, she was heading Postbank and Deutsche Bank teams across Germany and was the dedicated interface into Deutsche Bank's global Chief Operating Office (COO) organisation.

In 2015, Silke was appointed Chief Information Officer (CIO) Germany for Private and Business Clients (PBC) and later in the year as CIO for Private, Wealth and Commercial Clients (PW&CC). In this role she was responsible for the planning, development and compliant implementation of technology solutions and services supporting the bank's PW&CC business, including the digital roadmap for PW&CC. She was also member of the IT Security Committee and relationship manager to the internal risk and control functions.

Prior to joining Deutsche Bank, Silke held a number of senior management IT roles in Deutsche Börse Systems AG in Frankfurt for 15 years, leading technology teams through large-scale international application development projects in the area of trading and clearing, with special focus on rollout, service integration and testing.

She holds a doctorate degree in computer science from the TU Clausthal-Zellerfeld.
